To find out if you qualify, come in to fill out a prescreen.

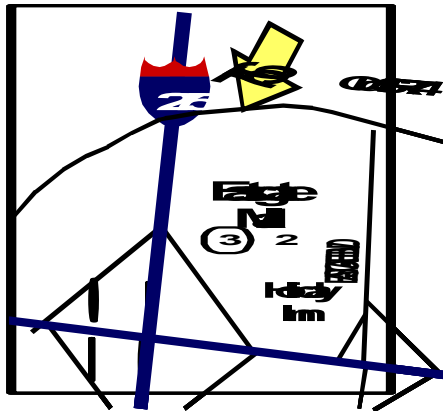
