Q: What is WIOA?

The Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act is the single source of Federal funding for Workforce Development Activities.

- WIOA is an extensive program that assists individuals in finding employment. Initially, we work on job search activities and if employment is unable to be attained we then look at training options. WIOA is a federally funded program that provides training money for individuals who need training or need to enhance their current skills.

Q: What is the Purpose of WIOA?

To increase the employment, retention, and earnings of participants, and increase occupational skill attainment by participants, and, as a result, improve the quality of the workforce, reduce welfare dependency, and enhance the productivity and competitiveness of the Nation.

Q: Who does WIOA serve?

WIOA services are available to individuals who fall into one of the following categories:

Adult

- Age 18 and over
- Proper US citizenship
- Proper Selective Service Registrant
- Income Based

Dislocated Worker

- No age requirement
- Proper US citizenship
- Proper Selective Service Registrant
- Laid off through no fault of his/her own due to downsizing, closure, or termination

Q: What is the WIOA Process?

- Request a prescreen from OhioMeansJobs Clermont County via phone at 513.943.3000 or via our website www.workforceoneclermont.com
- Complete the prescreen and return it to OhioMeansJobs Clermont County in person, via fax 513.943.3002 or via email at angie.hodges@jfs.ohio.gov and you will be provided with the next available date for the Q & A Session
- Attend the WIOA Q & A session
- Complete CORE and INTENSIVE Services (these services are required and will be explained during the Q & A Session)
- Complete the WIOA Packet and turn it into to your assigned consultant
- Orientation/Career Counseling/Assessment with your consultant. (TABE/Workkeys testing might be required at this point depending on skill sets)
- Packet completion-Education Plan and Employment Plan
- Case Approval
- Case Manager will notify you of your approval and you can begin your program
- Follow-up with your consultant monthly from the time you begin your program until you are re-employed.
